- b. John Lambie welcomed the CDC to Florida House, and explained Florida House status and mission.
- 2. Review/ Approval of October Meeting Notes
 - a. Significant discussion about the intent and process regarding meeting minutes
 - b. The idea is that there should be an opportunity for corrections while the minutes are in draft form and prior to approval at the following meeting.
 - c. An existing resource that may be useful is a 'Minutes Template' currently used by Health and Human Services.
 - d. Does the Collaborative desire for minutes to reflect actions and assignments or an involved summary?
 - e. Also issues about accuracy and transparency
 - f. The group agreed that this is an important aspect and there is an opportunity for enhancement; there is a learning curve in that there is not a perfect process; continuous improvement is to be expected as the Collaborative is learning and growing together.
