

kept confidential, shared with your team, or made public.


Save Your Settings

The Southeast North Carolina Community Platform lets you save custom filters and more. But to save and retrieve them, you must be registered or we won't know who they belong to.


Receive Updates

The Southeast North Carolina Community Platform can automatically notify you when changes to organizations or projects that you're associated with are changed, or when new features, data or information are added to the Platform.








From this screen, you can edit an organization's name, contact information, and Activity Code(s). You can also delete this organization, if they are no longer in operation.


Adding New Organizations
